
St. Vincent de Paul of Brown County welcomes your donations of non-perishable food items (in date) such as canned

CORDRY- SWEETWATER LOT OWNERS ASSOCIATION INC. Proposed Amendments to Bylaws

The CSLOA is proposing the following amendments to the bylaws. The proposed amendments are posted at the Clubhouse. Members in good standing shall have a maximum of three (3) weeks from the date of mailing of this newsletter to cast their votes. Ballots may be mailed to or hand-carried to the Board of Directors. A majority count of the ballots returned shall be binding.

ARTICLE II - MEMBERS Section 2. MEMBERSHIP FEE

The membership fee shall be fixed by the Board of Directors at its June meeting; payment of which shall make the member eligible for all rights of membership. The membership is non-refundable and non-transferable. The membership fee shall be due and payable on the first (1st) day of September each year. New lot owners who purchase property after June 1st shall be given a complimentary membership in the CSLOA until August 31st of the same year. Complimentary membership shall include all rights, privileges, and liabilities of membership in the CSLOA. Active members of the Cordry-Sweetwater Volunteers Fire & Ambulance Inc., owning property withinthe CSCD may join the CSLOA at a reduced rate set by the **CSLOA Board of Directors.** A list of those members shall be provided by the Fire Department prior to September 1st. The CSLOA shall keep accurate records of all mem**berships**

ARTICLE III - MEETINGS

Section 2. ANNUAL MEETINGS

The Annual meeting of the members shall be held on the third (3rd) Saturday of **September August**, at a time designated by the Board of Directors, for the purpose of electing directors and the presentation of annual reports. It shall be the duty of the Secretary to notify the editor of the CSLOA newsletter of the date, place and time of the Annual meeting, and that the meeting is for the purpose of electing directors and the presentation of Annual Reports, so the information can be printed in the August February CSLOA Newsletter. The Secretary shall also be responsible for notifying the person responsible for the Activity boards so the information can be posted on the

Activity boards at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance of the meeting. Members shall not have voting rights unless current dues are paid. Nominations shall not be accepted from the floor at the Annual meeting for the purpose of electing Directors.

ARTICLE V - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 1. NUMBER AND TENURE

The Board of Directors shall consist of seven (7) members elected by the membership to serve three (3) year terms. Terms are to be staggered so that on more than three (3) board members are elected each year. Board terms commence on September first (1st) and terminate on August thirty-first (31st).

Section 4. REMOVAL

A member of the Board of Directors may be removed from their position on the Board at any time for: 1) cause; 2) missing four (4) regular meetings in any fiscal **year** by a majority vote of the remaining Directors (at a special meeting of the Board of Directors called for such purpose). Section 7. OFFICERS AND DUTIES

A. SECRETARY – The Secretary shall keep a true and accurate record of the proceedings of all meetings, current and past, of the CSLOA and the Board of Directors which shall be filed in the CSLOA office and shall perform the duties usual and incidental to the office of Secretary. The Secretary shall be responsible for scheduling events in the Clubhouse and on its grounds, rental agreements and collecting rent due. All rents collected shall be turned over to the Treasurer for recording and deposit.

ARTICLE VI - APPOINTED POSITIONS

Section 1. CLUBHOUSE SUPERVISOR

The Clubhouse Supervisor shall be responsible for scheduling events in the Clubhouse and on its grounds, rental agreements and collecting rent due. All rents collected deposit. The Clubhouse Supervisor shall be responsible for the maintenance of all CSLOA property and shall secure bids for such maintenance or repair to present to the CSLOA Board for approval as needed. The Clubhouse Supervisor shall bring a report of the current and following months' activities to all meetings of the Board of Directors and a yearly calendar of all events, meetings, and rentals at the Clubhouse and on its grounds.

ARTICLE VIII - PROPERTY AND FACILITIES
Section 1. SCHEDULING

The Board of Directors shall shave the authority to approve or disapprove the use of the Clubhouse and all

other property and facilities owned by or controlled by the CSLOA. Further, the Board of Directors shall have jurisdiction over the conduct of those using said property equipment and facilities whether or not rent has been paid. All organizations and individuals shall file their intent to use CSLOA property and facilities with the **Clubhouse Supervisor Secretary** for approval and shall agree to abide by the Rules and Regulations approved by the Board of Directors.


